The tryout sessions will be held by age group and will consist of drills, exercises and scrimmages designed to allow the coaching staff to evaluate the skills, desire, attitude and potential of each player. Players will be placed on teams based upon their skills and competitive level. Existing TFA players must attend tryouts and will be re-evaluated for placement on teams. Through the implementation of these tryouts we can evaluate and place players appropriately, and in the case where a player cannot be placed, we will do everything possible to promptly give notification and an explanation if necessary.
